



#### **3<sup>rd</sup> March 1918** Treaty of Brest-Litovsk

Peace Treaty between Russia and Germany following the October Revolution in Russia and Russia's subsequent withdrawal from the war.

#### 21st March 1918 Ludendorff Offensive begins

Also known as the Spring Offensive. This attack on the Western Front was led by General Ludendorff. The surprise attack pushed the Allies back across old Somme battlefields towards Paris.

### **18<sup>th</sup> July 1918**Aisne-Marne Offensive begins

A counter attack by American and French forces, led by Marshal Foch, which stopped the Germans on the River Marne near Paris and began to push them back.

## 8<sup>th</sup> August 1918 Hundred Days Offensive begins with the Battle of Amiens

A surprise attack by the Allies, led by General Rawlinson, against German troops. This offensive continued until the end of the war.





### **30<sup>th</sup> September 1918**Ceasefire with Bulgaria comes in to effect

Bulgaria asked the Allies if they could discuss a ceasefire. Discussions took place in Salonica. The peace agreement was signed on 29<sup>th</sup> September 1918 and came into effect the next day at noon.

## 5<sup>th</sup> October 1918 Hindenburg Line broken through by Allies

After arriving at the supposedly impenetrable Hindenburg Line on 26th September 1918, the Allies eventually broke through on this day and began crossing open county.





# **30<sup>th</sup> October 1918**Ottoman Empire agrees a ceasefire

Ceasefire agreed by representatives from Britain and the Ottoman Empire. It marked the end of the Ottoman Empire's involvement in World War I.

#### **4**<sup>th</sup> **November 1918**Austria-Hungary agree a ceasefire

Peace agreement with the Allies sees Austria-Hungary withdraw from the war.





# 8<sup>th</sup> November 1918 Germans and Allies meet to discuss an Armistice

The German delegation led by Matthias Erzberger met representatives of the Allies led by Marshal Foch. Discussions took place in a railway carriage in the Forest of Compiègne in France.

#### 9<sup>th</sup> November 1918 German Kaiser abdicates

The leader of Germany, Kaiser Wilhelm II, steps down. Germany becomes a republic.
